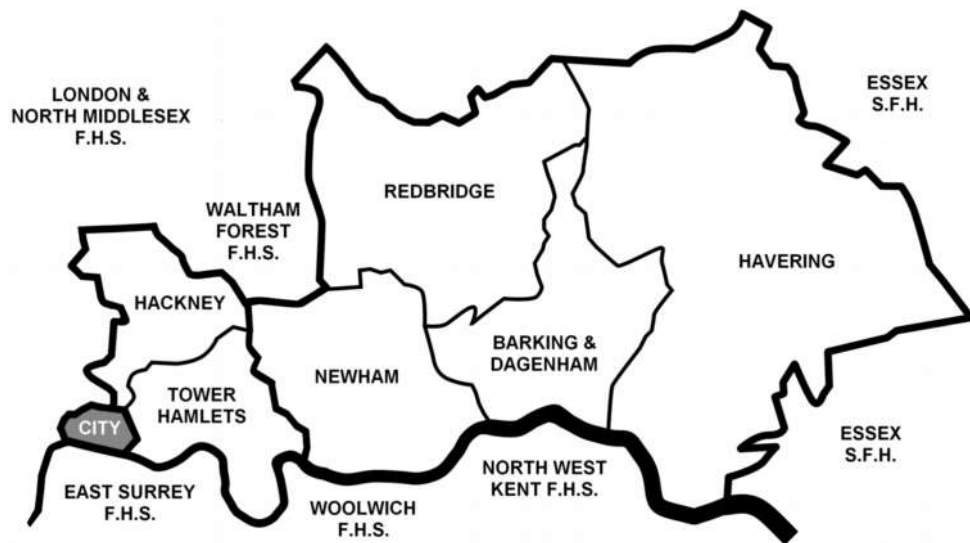

The EoLFHS Area of Interest



The area covered by the EoLFHS is defined by the London boroughs to the east of the City of London. These boroughs were historically parts of the counties of Middlesex or Essex with the River Lea forming the boundary between the two counties. Boroughs to the west, Hackney and Tower Hamlets were part of Middlesex, those to the east, Newham, Redbridge, Barking & Dagenham and Havering were part of Essex. This split is reflected in the historic records which are to be found in a wide variety of locations.
